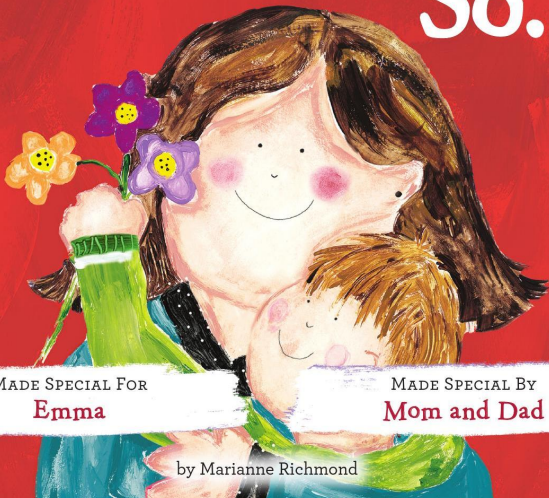

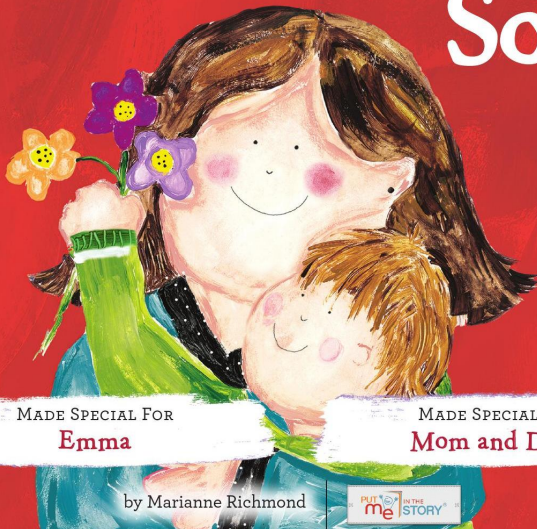

Emma.

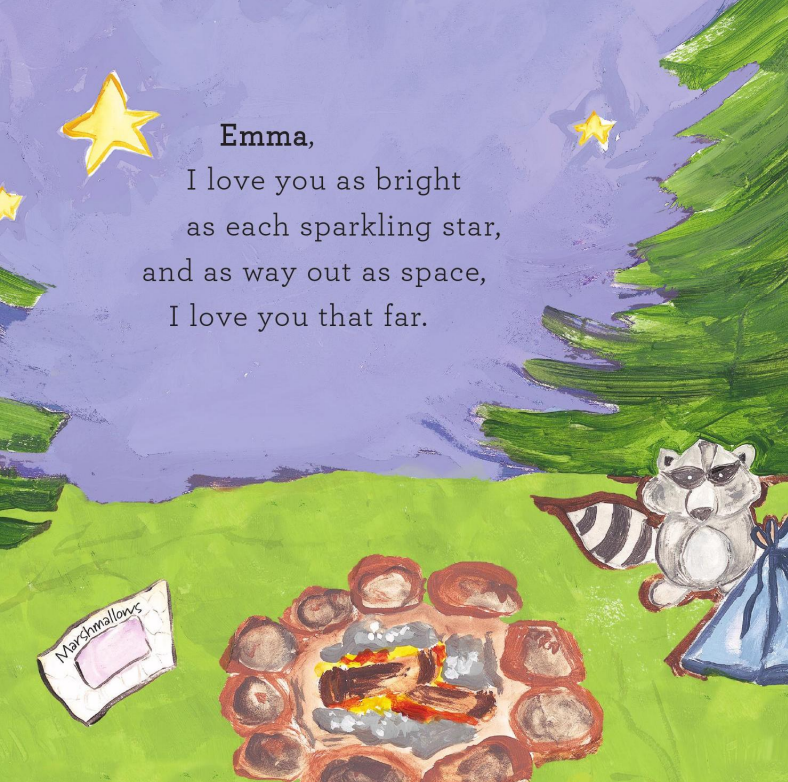

“How much is ‘SO’?”

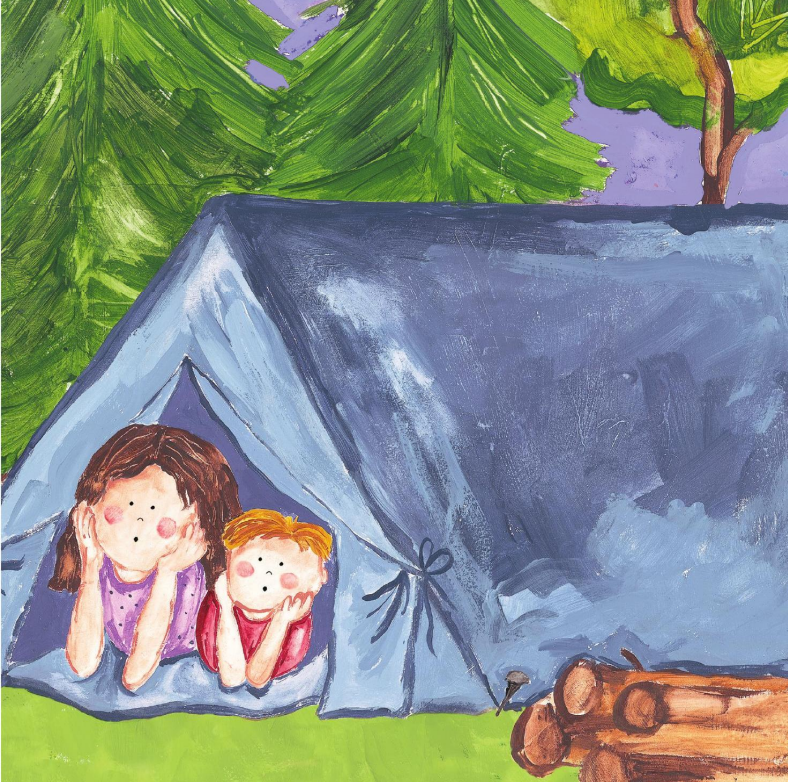
Way, way

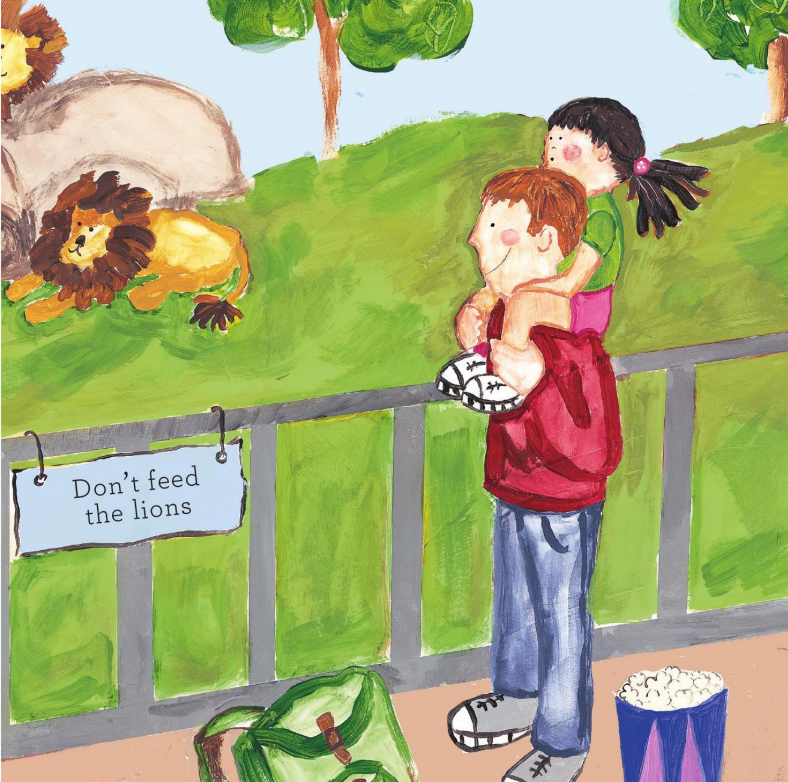
Emma,

I love you that high.







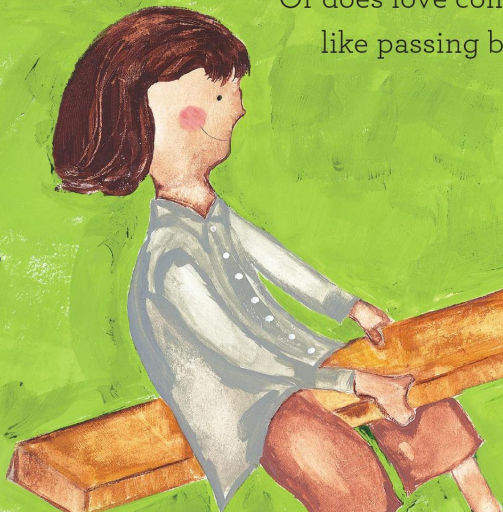
Emma,

I love you like this.

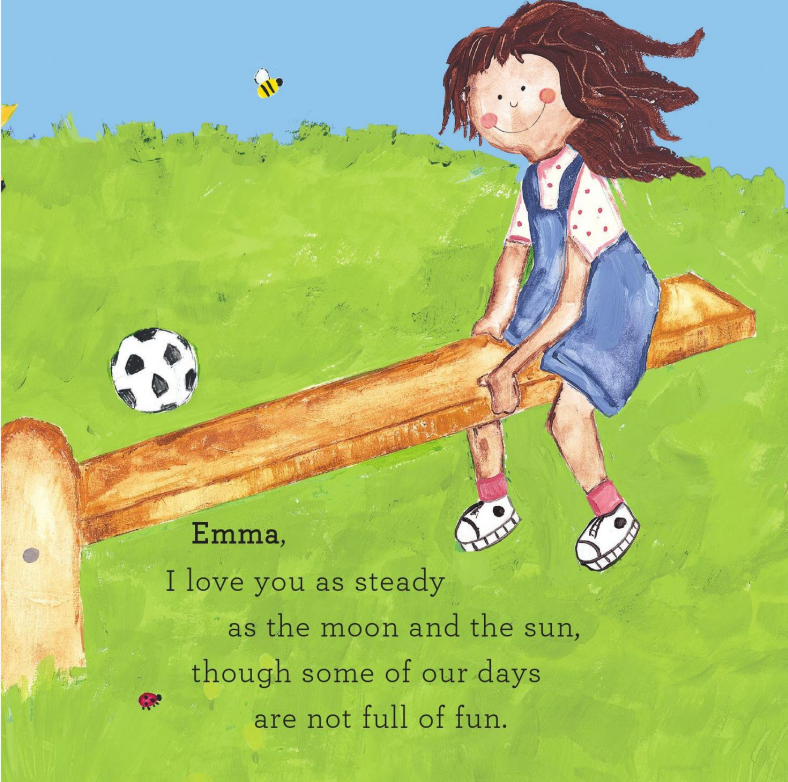


“Do you love me every day?”

you ask with surprise.

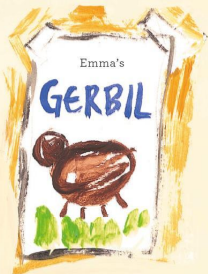
“Or does love come and go

or made a big mess?”

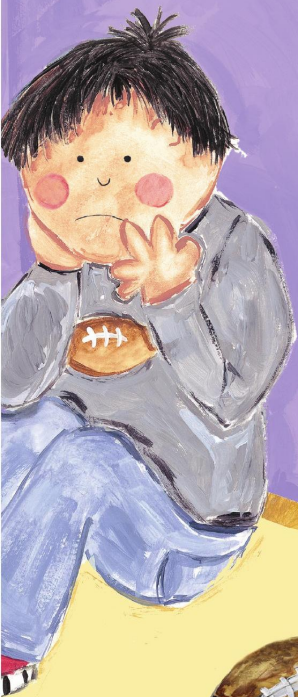


Emma,

my hug and my wiggle.



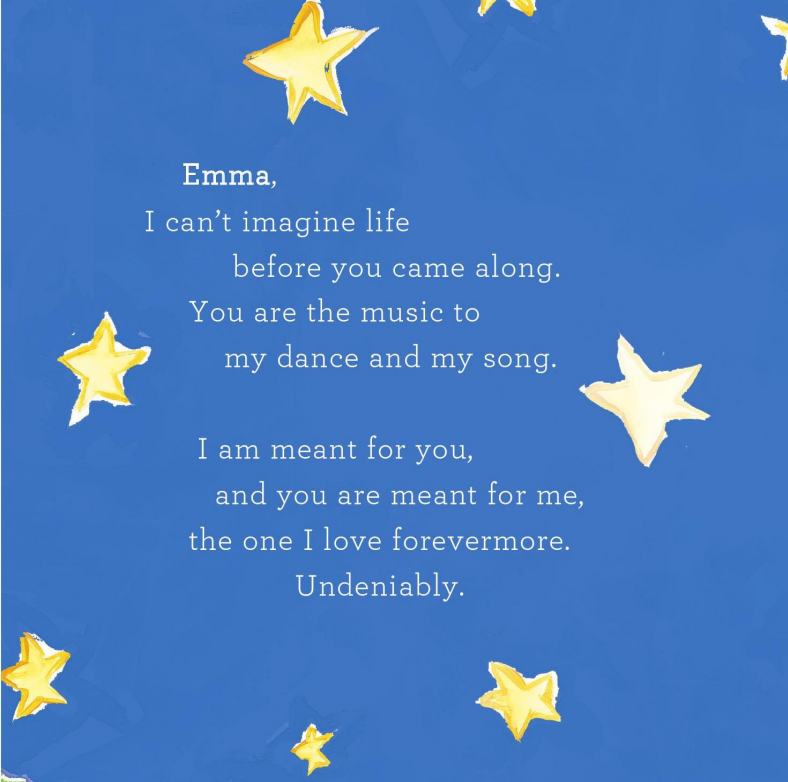
Hanging out with you

You are the music to

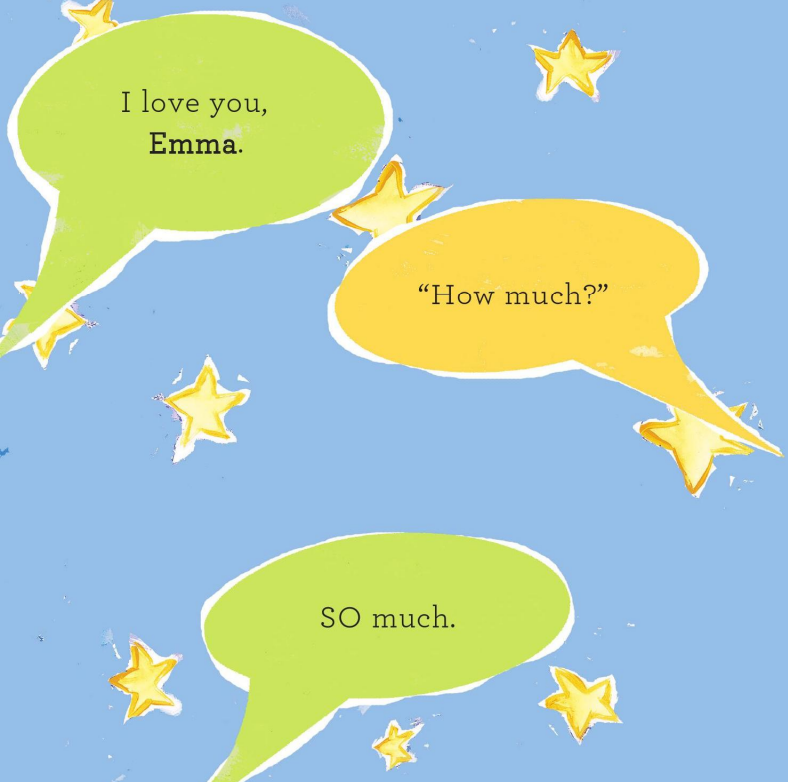
my dance and my song.
